Signify contributions for industry associations and coalitions for sustainable growth

Signify actively engages with governmental organizations, emphasizing the environmental and socioeconomic benefits of energy efficiency, the potential of connected LED lighting and joining public debates addressing sustainability issues. We share updates on initiatives and developments in this area on our website in our <u>Press Releases</u>.

As formalized in our Integrity Code, Signify adopted a policy of prohibition of contributions, in money or in kind, to political parties, political organizations or individuals engaged in politics. Signify takes part in industry associations and coalitions for sustainable growth and we share our contributions. The total contributions and expenditures amounted EUR 4.67 million in 2019.

The largest contributions and expenditures are made by Signify to:

(1) the National Electrical Manufacturers Association 'NEMA' manufacturers to develop performance standards and promote product interoperability to increase market demand while improving safety to mitigate risks (EUR 0.9 million)
(2) World Economic Forum which engages the foremost political, business, cultural and other leaders of society to shape global, regional and industry agendas (EUR 0.3 million)

(3) Lighting Europe to engage on standards in light technology (EUR 0.2 million).

As Signify we address the following main issues with the contributions and expenditures:

- Within our industry we engage with associations to develop uniform standards in lighting technology and connectivity (total of contributions and expenditures of EUR 0.5 million).
- Signify considers climate change an important focus area with, in addition to the move towards renewable energy, also an emphasis on energy efficiency and becoming carbon neutral (total of contributions and expenditures of EUR 0.4 million).
