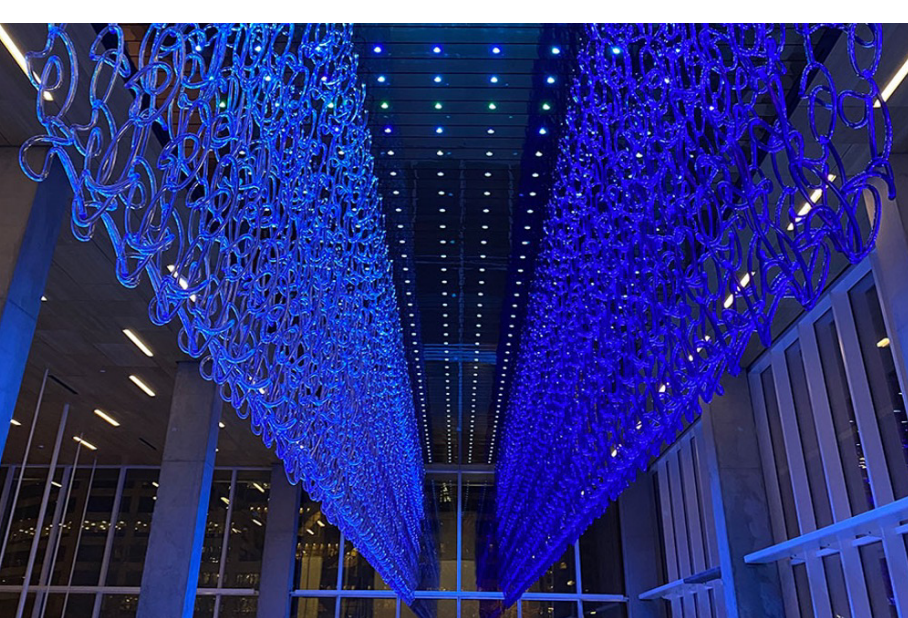


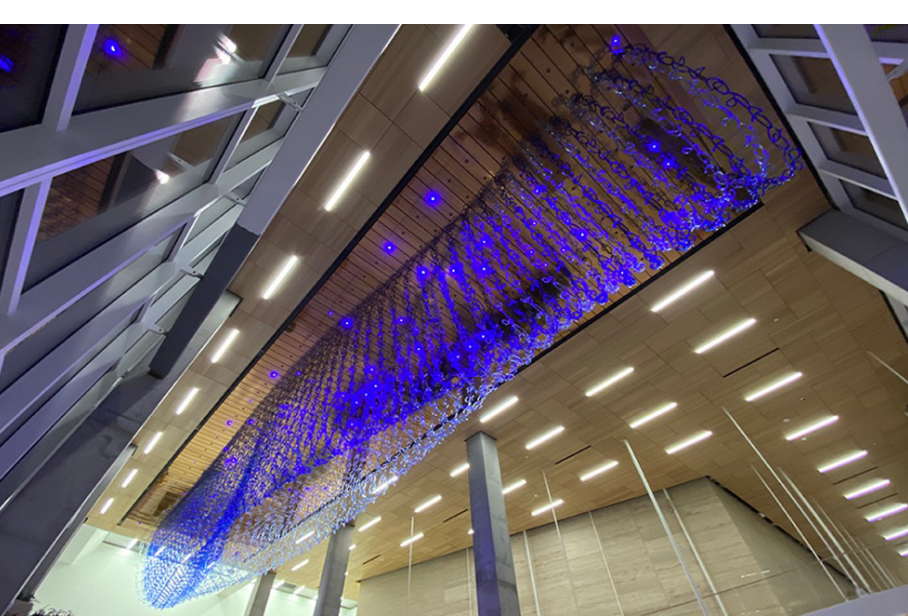
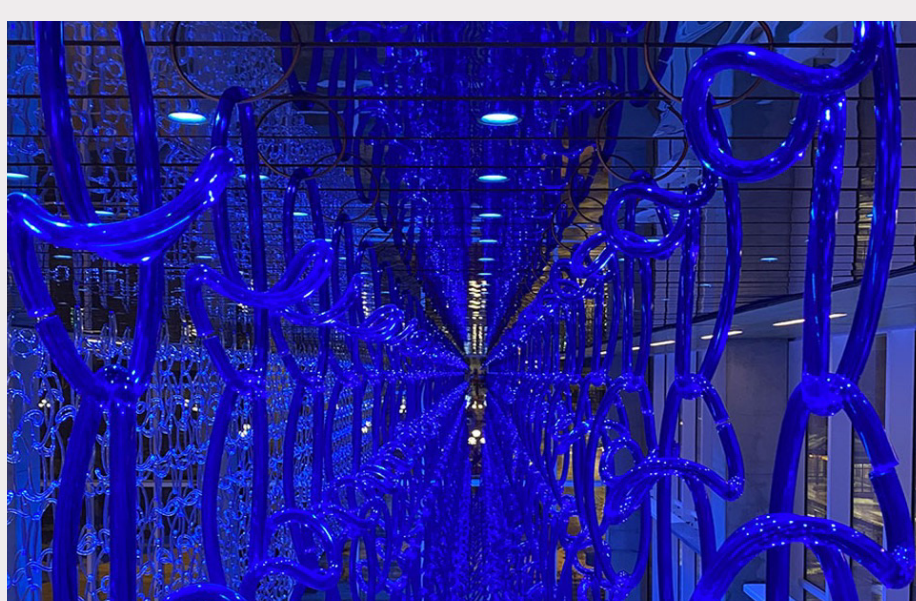
Current Conditions

Formations Studio, Minneapolis, United States



Tristan Al-Haddad of Formations Studio and Adam Rixey of SESCO Lighting teamed up to create an interactive light art installation that is controlled and transformed by changing weather patterns. Remaining true to Al-Haddad's signature theme of "creating visceral experiential sensations and exploring concepts of matter-energy transformations," the mesmerizing sculpture displays a different lighting effect each day according to weather conditions.

Color Kinetics luminaires were selected for their ability to meet the stringent standards of the LEED Platinum building, and to provide uniquely addressable color-changing nodes tucked into tight-spaces, as required for the project. Color Kinetics FlexElite IntelliHue (490 nodes) delivered a royal blue-purple color and saturated color gamut desired for the art concept.



The nodes were mounted in a 457 x 457 mm (18 x 18 in) grid to the back side of a plywood ceiling panel using a custom mounting fixture to achieve an effect that resembles a pixel in a matrix.



Tristan Al-Haddad, leading his **talented team** at **Formations Studio**, has repeatedly blended **creative art structures** with modern, color-changing lighting. When selecting options for the Current Conditions tight-profile mounting, **Tristan's vision needed the Color Kinetics FlexElite IntelliHue fixtures** to deliver reliable, individually addressable, low-profile, and saturated color-changing light nodes."
